ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

This workshop celebrates the unique decorative style that developed during the Elizabethan era of sinuous, coiling stems supporting an array of colourful flowers, enhanced by the sparkle of tiny gilt paillettes. Borrowing the style but employing more contemporary stitch techniques and stranded silk threads, this design is worked as a square mirror frame, making the finished piece useful as well as beautiful. All techniques used to stitch the frame and construction information will be covered in class.

The kitset will include:

- · Silk duchess satin with the design transferred
- Stranded silk threads
- Rayon thread
- Gilt paillettes
- Needles
- Thin wadding
- Card
- Class notes

You will need to bring:

- 25cm good quality embroidery hoop with the inner ring bound (with stand if you have one)
- Fabric adhesive (Fray Check, Fray Stop)
- Your usual sewing kit including sharp embroidery scissors, scissors to cut fabric, thimble, pins, and any personal magnification, lighting etc
- Hand cream
