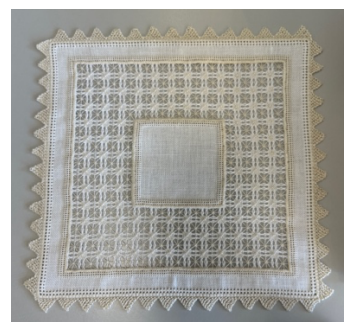


Hawke's Bay Embroiderer's Guild:

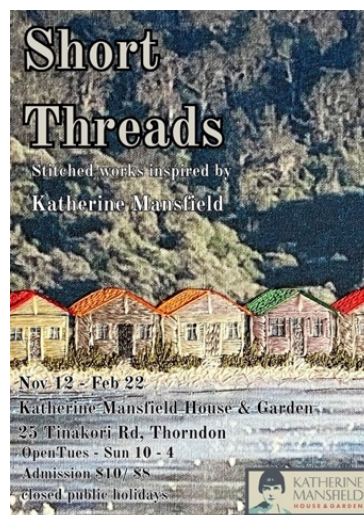
Change Of Details:

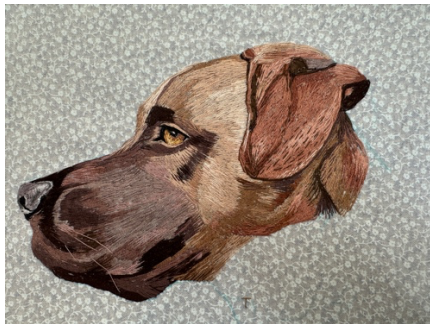

Day Finishes at 3pm

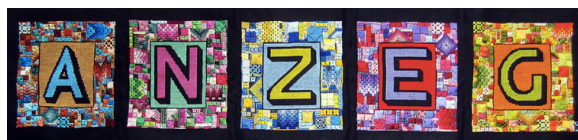
What To Bring: Your current stitching project
