ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

In this workshop, you will use a variety of techniques to stitch the elements of the Rising Phoenix onto a hand-dyed silk background. This design includes a number of 3-dimensional techniques using padding and wire. Fabric painting will also be introduced as a method of colouring one of the elements. No prior stumpwork experience is required. The piece will not be completed in class but how to stitch each of the elements will be covered and full instructions will be provided.

ABOUT THE TUTOR

Sandra is an embroiderer, weaver and braider from Wellington. She has been embroidering most of her adult life and experiments with a variety of embroidery techniques. Her current focus is on Schwalm and stumpwork. She is an experienced tutor and has tutored a number of workshops in her areas of expertise.

- · Pattern and full instructions
- · All required fabrics
- · Wire.

Participants should bring:

- DMC threads or other.
- Wire cutters (if you have some)
- Needles tapestry and sharp
- Embroidery hoops preferably about 20 25cm in diameter. A smaller one could also be useful
- Fray stop
- · Sewing pins
- Sewing kit
- Sewing thread in a colour similar to the fabric or thread being used.
- Tape measure or ruler
