Technique(s): Felt embellished with metal threads and jewels; beaded edging

Kit cost: **\$40 for 2 decorations**Sample size: Various, up to 10cm.

ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

Add a little sparkle to your holiday tree with your own heirloom ornaments! Using glittering embellishments like jewels, chains, shisha mirrors, kundan stones and gorgeous metallic threads, these ornaments will brighten up any tree they adorn. The bright felt backgrounds and beaded edging complete these delightful little ornaments. You will learn to work with metal threads and how to successfully attach jewels, chains and beaded edgings. Students will be surveyed prior so they can choose two kits from the pictured decorations. Expect to finish at least one of them during the class.

WORKSHOP NEEDS LIST #211: Christmas Decorations

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Kit cost: \$40 for 2 decorations

Kit includes fabrics, felt, kundan stones, chain, shisha, metal threads, beads, glue, sewing threads and detailed instructions.

Participants should bring:

- Non-slip hoop, 6-8" (2 if possible, one for each project)
- Hands free stand or quick-grip 6" clamps
- Needles: Sharp #10 or long beading needle #10
- Scissors suitable for thread and felt, as well as metal threads (serrated goldwork scissors recommended)
- Marking pen
- Tweezers fine pointed, either straight or with bent tips
- · Thread conditioner or beeswax
- Baking paper ~20cm (protection for ironing fusibles)
- Lighting and magnification as preferred
