This will be a fun class in which everyone will create an original work using simple stitch and colour.

Your finished piece can be used as the front of a bag or a wall hanging.

WORKSHOP NEEDS LIST

#236: A Rose By Any Name

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Kit cost: \$5

The tutor will provide:

- Notes.
- Some specialty threads and ribbons.

Participants should bring:

- Felt for backing. 35x100cm if you'd like to make a large bag.
- Various fabrics to suit your chosen colour scheme.
- Chiffon scarf large enough to cover the entire embroidery.
- Threads to suit the colour scheme in a variety of weights. I used Perle 5 and 8 plus stranded and variegated cottons. A few metallic threads.
- Novelty yarns and sparkly threads, ribbons or braids.
- Beads.
- Needles: Chenilles plus beading and tacking needles.
- Tacking threads in a contrasting colour.
- Scissors for fabric, embroidery and paper.
- Pins and small safety pins.
- Usual sewing requisites – eg magnifying glass, light, thimble etc.
- Notebook and pen.
- A sense of adventure.
