ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

This project brings the vibrant traditional filet embroidery from Brazil's Alagoas region to life – admire bright variegated threads as they weave through a larger scale mesh. Used widely on everything from clothing to household items, this embroidery is both decorative and expressive. This project is an invitation to explore and play with gorgeous colours while creating a sampler of basic filet stitches.

Julie has been stitching since she was a child, inspired and taught by generations of talented embroiderers. She is interested in a wide variety of stitching techniques and is always keen to expand on her embroidery knowledge. 

Total costs: 2-day workshop fee: \$200 + FULL kit cost: \$62 = \$262 -or-

+ PARTIAL kit cost: \$33 = \$233





The net and mounting instructions will be provided to participants prior to class, so that they can prepare their frame before the workshop starts. Choose from Pastel (left) or Bright (right) shades. In the partial kit you will receive the instructions and net, but you supply the threads (Perle 5 or equivalent).

The kitset will include:

- Printed instructions and stitch diagrams
- Net fabric (primary colour is blue but you can request ecru if you wish to dye another colour)
- Threads: Choose from Pastel -or- Bright
- Needle

You will need to bring:

- Embroidery frame (35cm sq internal edges), clamp or hands-free stand to hold frame while working (you need both hands free for this)
- · Heavy thread for stringing net
- Needles: Chenille 22 or 24
- Scissors
- Any lighting or magnification you'd usually use
