ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

A needle packet holder is something every stitcher needs – and this will make a beautiful and useful addition to your embroidery kit.

Students will learn an alternate way of working chain stitch as an outline and various counted filling stitches that comprise the background of Colbert work.

The construction will be talked about, as well as the edging which comprises Hedebo buttonhole and three-sided stitch.
