ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

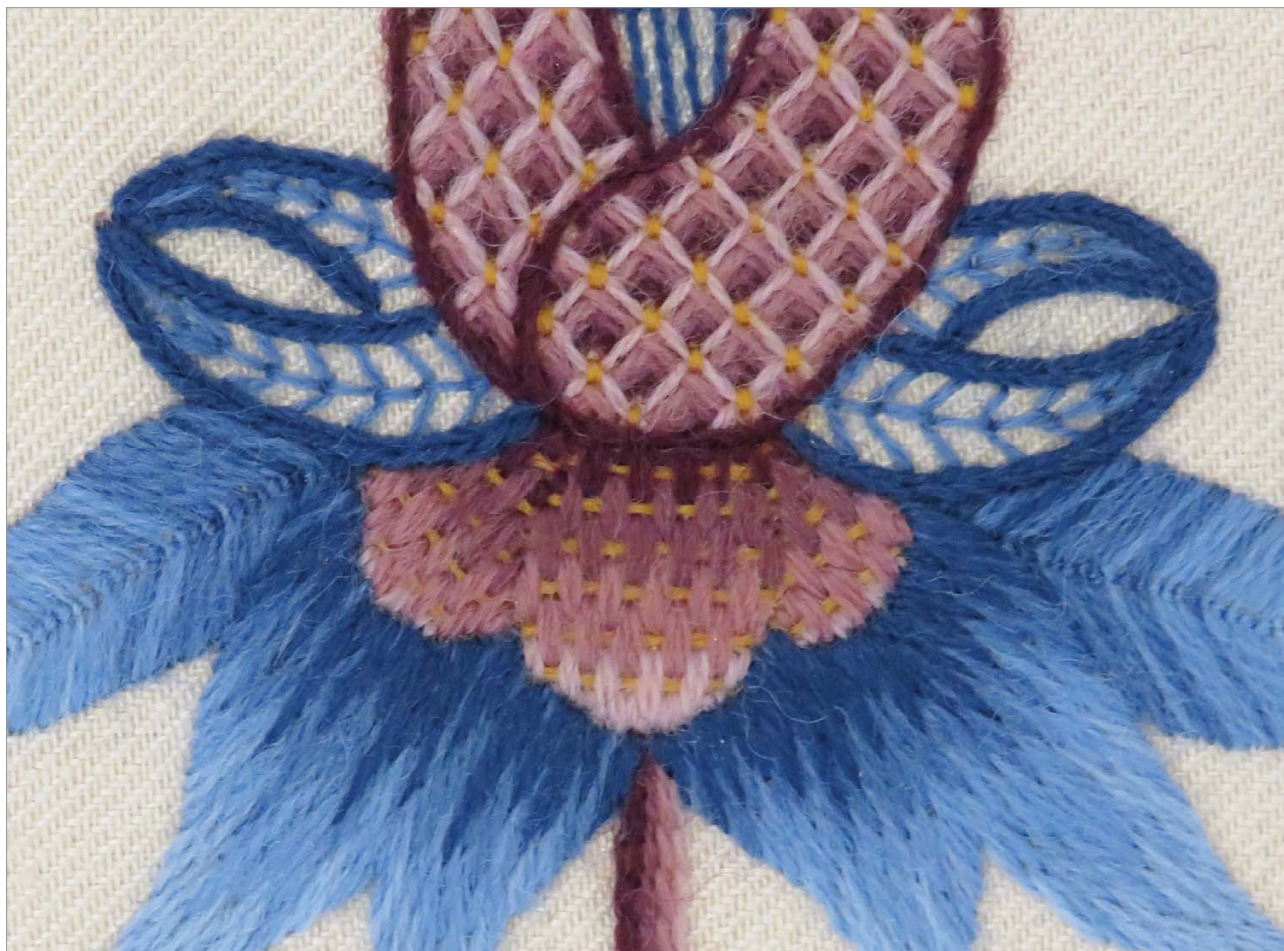

WORKSHOP NEEDS LIST

#219: Ready To Flourish

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Total costs: 2-day workshop fee: \$200 + kit cost: \$50 = **\$250**

Crewel embroidery stitches to be taught include heavy chain, trellis, fly stitch, raised stem band, long and short and Burden stitch. Students supply their own Appletons crewel wool so they can choose their own colours.

The kitset will include:

- Linen twill with design drawn on
- Needles
- Comprehensive notes

You will need to bring:

- Appletons crewel wool in 2 colour ways each consisting of 4 shades progressing from light to dark (8 skeins total)
- A contrast 'pop' skein can be added if desired
- 8 inch embroidery hoop – prefer hands free
- Pencil, ruler, eraser and sharpener
- Your usual sewing kit including sharp scissors, needles, pins, magnifying glass, lighting etc
