Tararua Regional Group (Presidents & Secretaries) is focusing on the long term sustainability of guilds in our region so has three groups working on different projects with this intention.

- Record Management working group. Running guilds takes up a lot of time which can make recruitment of new officers and committee members difficult. This working group is looking at what can be learned from each other's guilds to streamline guild administration and records management, reduce duplication, save time and make the jobs easier.
- The Data Gathering working group is gathering information to identify whether we're meeting the interests of the guilds' membership, providing short and long term solutions where we are not; and ways to attract new members.
- The Exhibition working group is planning a regional exhibition to give members an opportunity to exhibit their work, promoting embroidery to the public with the aim of encouraging people to take up embroidery as well as join our guilds.
