Parcels can be couriered or hand delivered – remember to attach a swing tag to the back of the work and D-rings to enable easy hanging. For the safety of all, no glass or perspex please. Insurance of the work is the exhibitor's responsibility. Refer to the Conditions of Entry on the website for all packaging and return courier requirements.

Jo Dixey wrote a piece on page 72 of Threads #91 (October 2025) giving helpful tips on how to package your work. It makes the coordinator's job so much easier if you name your work and all the packaging in which it is wrapped.

I'm looking forward to receiving a bounty of beautiful embroidery to wow the selectors and make our Threads of Connection exhibition truly exceptional.
