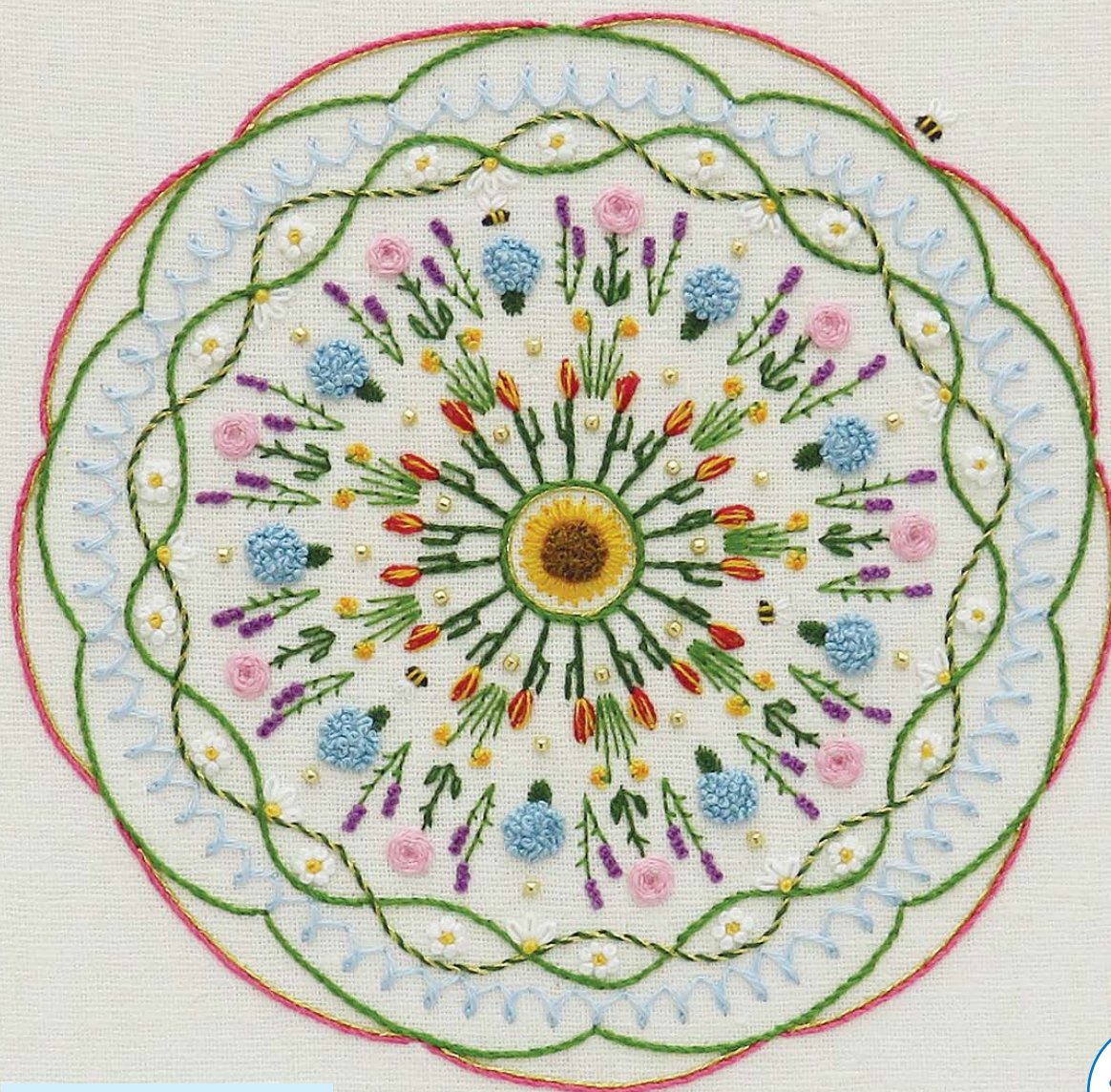

Technique(s): Various surface stitch techniques

ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

Learn how to combine a variety of surface stitches to create a flower patch that is complete with daisies, lavender, roses, hydrangeas, daffodils, tulips, a sunflower, and bees. Beads and DMC Diamant thread are added to provide some shiny elements and make the garden glisten. Stitched on a linen cotton blend, the finished piece may simply be framed or is suitable for adding to a bag or a patchwork project.

Pam has been stitching for as long as she can remember and particularly enjoys using a variety of surface stitchery techniques. She started learning more formal embroidery techniques around 10 years ago, and in more recent years has been making kits and teaching classes. WORKSHOP NEEDS LIST

#226: Flower Patch

Total costs: 2-day workshop fee:

\$200 + kit cost: \$20 = **\$220**

The kitset will include:

- Instructions
- Linen and felt
- Threads
- Beads and beading needle

You will need to bring:

- Hoop – 7" (180 mm) to 8" (205 mm) diameter
- Needles:

Sharps – I use a size 10 embroidery needle.

Tapestry – I use a size 28.

Note: The needle sizes above are what I prefer to use.

Please bring these or the sizes that you prefer for stitching with 1-2 strands of cotton.

- Your usual sewing kit including sharp embroidery scissors etc and any personal magnification and/or lighting
