ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

The embroidery on this workbag was inspired by traditional embroidery patterns on the collars and yokes of old English peasant smocks. The different regional designs have been simplified and the addition of wool felt appliqué gives the project bag a contemporary look. The embroidery and appliqué will not all be completed by the end of the workshop but all techniques and stitches will be covered and detailed notes will be provided to assist with the construction and completion of the bag.

WORKSHOP NEEDS LIST #219: Felt and Feather Bag

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Kit cost: \$95

The kit will include:

- Cotton/linen outer fabric with design pre-traced
- · Interfaced cotton lining and interlining
- Embroidery threads and wool felt
- Full pattern and detailed instructional notes will be provided.

Participants should bring:

- Fine sharp embroidery scissors
- Small sharp scissors for cutting paper
- Chenille needles, size 22
- HB mechanical pencil
- Pins
- · Medium/light grey sewing thread for tacking
- A magnifier or eye-glass clip-on magnifier is recommended
 Note: An embroidery hoop is not required.
