In this fun class you get to play with colour and learn canvaswork stitches like Rhodes, Amadeus Arrow, reverse chain, cushion and more. You will also learn how to finish each piece and leave with handy instructions so you can make it for a friend. The colour choice is up to you so raid your stash!

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Total costs: 2-day workshop fee: \$200 + kit cost: \$6 = \$206

The kitset will include full notes.

You will need to bring:

- 30cm square 24-count Congress Cloth
- Tapestry needles: 24 or 26
- A variegated floss or perle 8 or 12
- A selection of 5 or 6 colours that work with the variegated thread and canvas (I used mostly floss)



- Metallic thread
- Your usual sewing kit including sharp scissors, needles, pins, magnifying glass, lighting etc
