ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

Schwalm is a German whitework technique characterised by filled elements outlined in both coral stitch and chain stitch. In this workshop, you will be introduced to Schwalm and guided through completing the Edelweiss design. The design incorporates a range of pulled and drawn thread filling stitches. No prior experience of Schwalm is required. The piece will not be completed in class but all the stitches will be covered and full instructions will be provided.

ABOUT THE TUTOR

Sandra is an embroiderer, weaver and braider from Wellington. She has been embroidering most of her adult life and experiments with a variety of embroidery techniques. Her current focus is on Schwalm and stumpwork. She is an experienced tutor and has tutored a number of workshops in her areas of expertise.



WORKSHOP NEEDS LIST

#207: Edelweiss

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Kit cost: \$20

The tutor will provide the pattern and full instructions to enable participants to complete the Edelweiss design.



Participants should bring:

- 30x30cm piece of Belfast linen (32 count).
A lower count linen fabric can also be used.
- Perle 8 thread and Perle 12 thread in the same colour.
- Needles – tapestry and sharp.
- Embroidery hoop – preferably about 20-25cm in diameter.
- Embroidery scissors.
- Sewing pins.
- Sewing kit.
- Sewing thread in a colour similar to the fabric or thread being used.
