WORKSHOP NEEDS LIST #222: The Orb

Kit cost: **\$15**

The kit will include the template, cardboard and constructions notes so the project can be fi nished at home.

Participants should bring:

- 18 count canvas, 30x36 cm cut into 3 pieces 30x12 cm.
 - Either masking tape the edges,



stitch fabric around and lace into a frame if you want to work in a frame – as the pieces are fairly small they can be worked in the hand... personal choice

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- 2 balls perle 8 (contrasting colours)
- Sewing thread (for lacing)
- Tapestry 24 needle
- Usual sewing kit
