

ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

Darning can be found in many parts of the world, presented in different styles. It can be both functional and decorative. The process of pattern darning is relaxing and addictive.

The finished sampler has 30 patterns, some original and others based on traditional designs.

The patterns can either be stitched with one strand of thread on 32 count linen or with two strands on 28 or 30 count linen.

Jill has been embroidering and quilting since the late 80s and is experienced in a wide range of techniques. She has been a tutor since 2011 in both embroidery and patchwork. Jill has a passion for using pattern and colour to create embroidery, whether it be in counted work or surface stitching, and likes to share that passion with others.

WORKSHOP NEEDS LIST#231: Pattern Darning Sampler

Kit cost: \$15

The tutor will provide notes.

Participants should bring:

1 fat quarter of even weave linen in either
 28 or 30 count (stitched with 2 stranded threads) or
 32 count (stitched with 1 stranded thread).

Note: Choose a linen that isn't too rigid or has too many thick threads running through it. Belfast is a good option.

- 6 stranded thread, either solid or shaded rather than variegated.
 Approx 18 metres for one strand or
 35 metres for two strands.
- Tapestry needles
- 6" to 10" hoop (your preference)
- · Light or magnifiers if required
- · Regular sewing equipment
