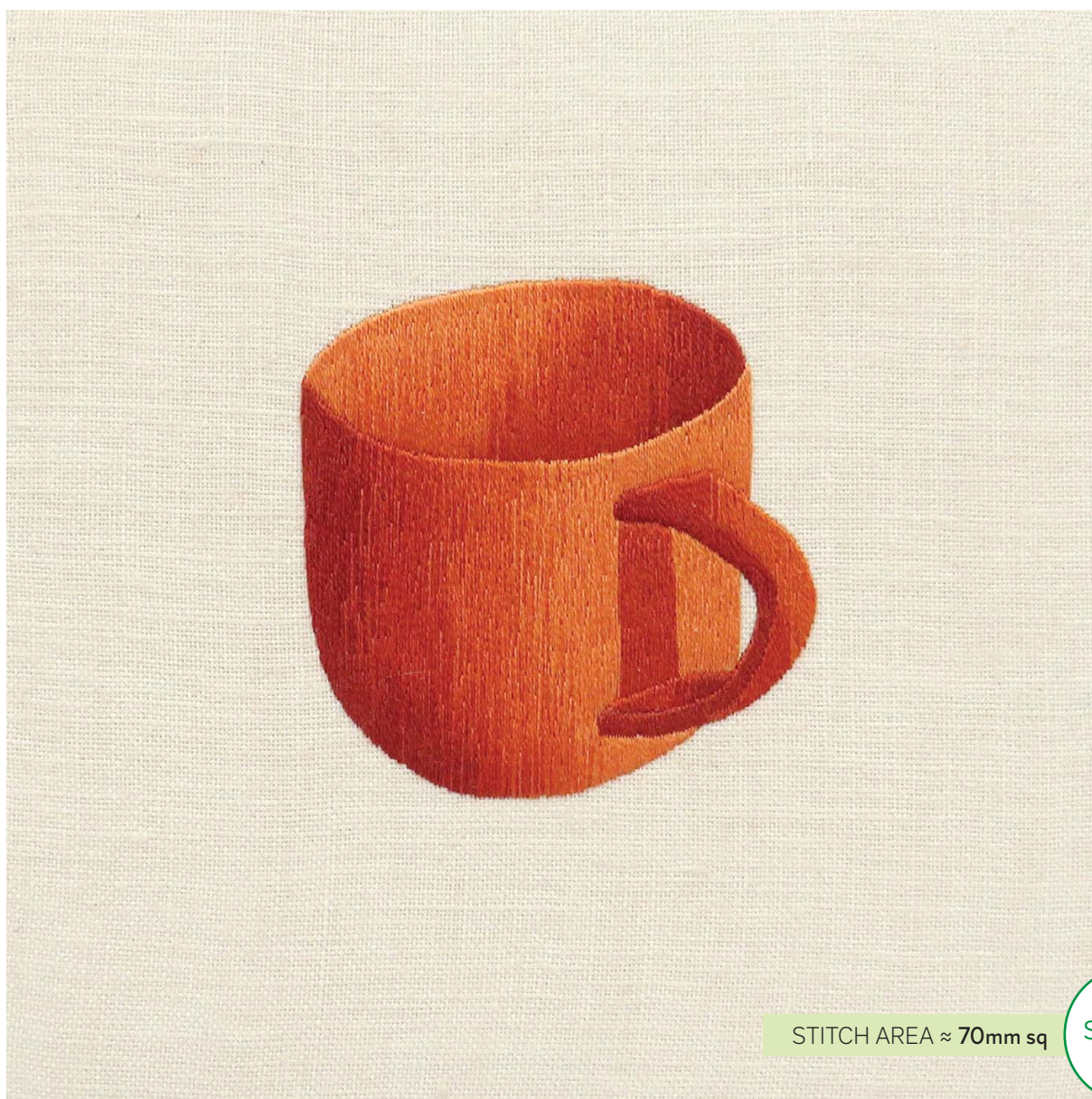

Total costs: 2-day workshop fee: \$200 + kit cost: \$0 = **\$200**

Over the course of the workshop, you'll create a striking stitched cup while mastering the techniques of tapestry shading in a relaxed and encouraging environment.

The tutor will supply the design of the cup. It measures 7cm square.

You will need to bring:

- 8" hoop, hands-free if you have one
- Washed calico to fit hoop
- Background fabric to fit hoop, about calico weight
- 4 shades of stranded cotton, light gradually shading to dark
- Packet of size 10 embroidery/crewel needles
- Your usual sewing kit and any lighting or magnification you need
- A notebook and HB pencil, eraser and sharpener
